Dashboard overview

When you log in, the dashboard page will load.

The left hand column **1**

will give you information about your subscription, and the center column **2**

will include messages from your administrator or Techstreet.

You can search for documents by number, title or key words **3**

Searching

As you type in search terms, the search engine will suggest document numbers and titles from your subscription **1**

If your search terms don't match a document number or title, the search engine will look across title, description, and more to find relevant standards.

You can elect to search off subscription using Search Modifiers on the left **2**

You can also elect to search across the full text of all documents here.

You can choose to sort the documents by relevance or by date of publication. **3**

The document detail page is where you can download the standard and see important details about the standard, like whether or not it's the most recent, and whether or not redlines are available .

Click on the download button and the standard will be downloaded to your computer. **1**

In addition to offering access to the latest edition of the standard, any redlined version will be available here, as well as links to historical editions of the same standard. **2**

FileOpen associates the standard with your computer, so it's only accessible from there.
